The second book is required as the "one school, one read" title:

Unplugged by Gordon Korman

These titles are readily available at your public library or book store. Once a book is read, your child is asked to complete the attached book report form either by writing directly on it or by typing it into a Google Docs. A copy of the form is available on the St. Rita School website that may be downloaded at home. Book reports will be collected on the first day of school and count as the first literature grade of the year.
