<u>Incoming sixth graders-</u> Select <u>two</u> titles from the following list:

K. DiCamillo: The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane; The Tale of Despereaux

- C. S. Lewis: The Chronicles of Narnia (series)
- E. B. White: Charlotte's Web
- R. Riordan: Percy Jackson; Trials of Apollo; Magnus Chase; The Kane Chronicles (series)
- M. Christopher: The Kid Who Only Hit Homers (or any title by the author)
- G. Korman: Masterminds

<u>Incoming seventh graders-</u>Select <u>two</u> titles from the following list:

Under the Same Sky by Cynthia DeFelice Lost in the Sun by Lisa Graff Belly Up (and other FunJungle titles in the series) by Stuart Gibbs Escaping the Giant Wave by Peg Kehret The Watsons Go to Birmingham- 1963 by Christopher Paul Curtis Michael Vey (multiple titles in the series) by Richard Paul Evans

<u>Incoming eighth graders</u> Choose <u>one</u> book based on personal interest from your library or bookstore. In other words, <u>one</u> book is whatever YOU want it to be. Then, select <u>one</u> true-story title from the following list:

Once a book is read, your child is asked to complete the book report form either by writing directly on it or by typing it into a Google Docs and printing it. A copy of the form is available on the St. Rita School website and may be downloaded at home. Book reports will be collected during the first week of school and count as the first literature grade of the year.
